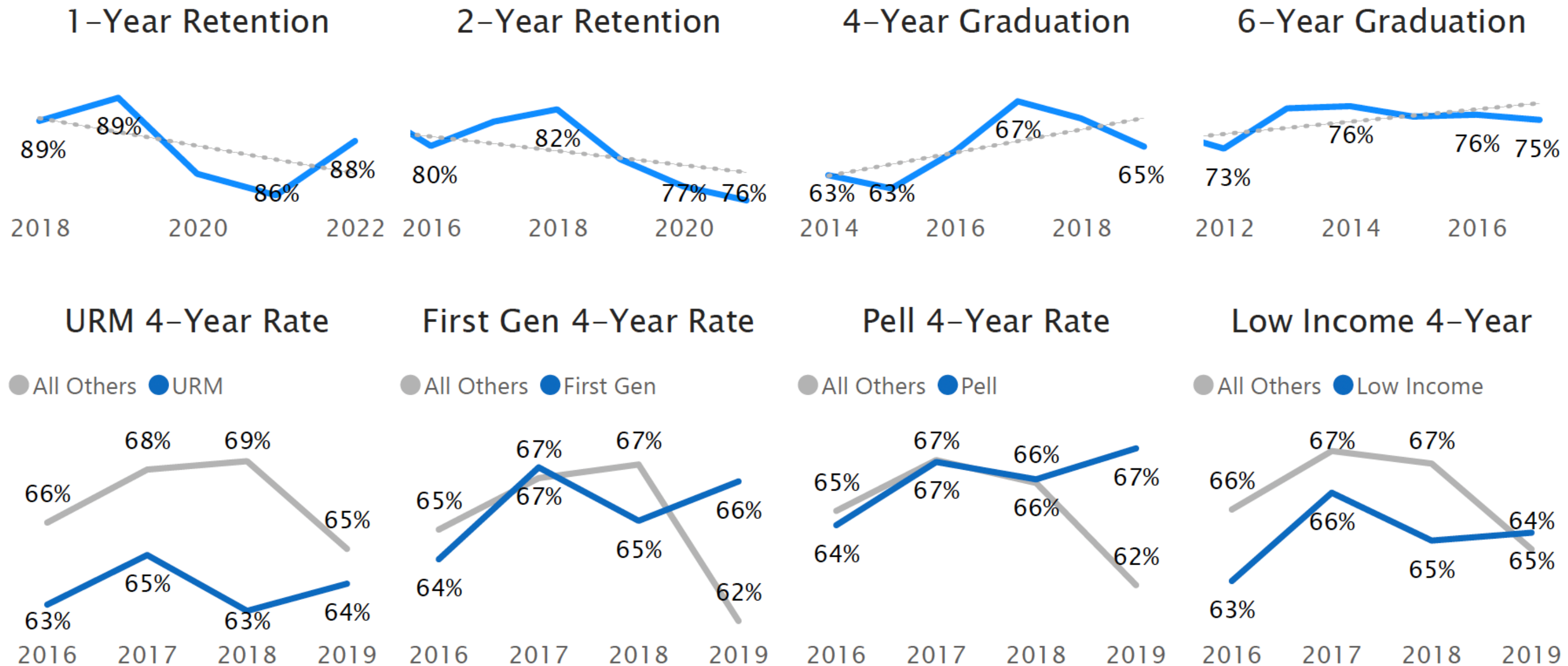
Undergraduate Retention & Graduation
