





### Headcount of Majors




### Undergraduate Credit Hours Taught in the Department

### Destination of Graduates Who Left This Major




### Source of Graduates Who Changed into This Major




## Entering Cohort 1-Year Retention (Fall-to-Fall Persistence, Includes Full- and Part-Time Entrants)

### Frosh Retention




### Transfer Retention




## Entering Cohort Graduation (Finished Any Program at UCR)
